All of these statements were rooted in and based upon the actual written and spoken/transcribed ideas, thoughts, dreams and stories collected in PPCC's Street Party in September 2022, and at 12 Story Circles conducted by Wonderlust in Oct-Dec. 2022.
- Approximately 44 participants stayed to the very end and used their dots (5 each) to amplify the group statements made by all participants at each table/topic.
- Remember, dot color corresponds to party hat color which in turn corresponds to each participant's self-identification.

LIVE: Change: What we need to be remade so we can do better in the next 10 years. (3 cards, 3 statements)

- LV-C-1: We need to change empty lots and vacant buildings so we can have more green spaces in the next 10 years. (2 dots: 0 red, 0 purple, 1 green, 1 blue)
- LV-C-2: We need to change perceptions of living conditions so we can have pride and investments in the next 10 years. (1 dot: 0 red, 0 purple, 1 green, 0 blue)
- LV-C-3: We need to change the profit profitability of owning empty blighted homes and buildings so that we can have owners and residents have more equity and benefits from their emotional and financial investments in the next 10 years, instead of the private equity, uninterested incompetent and absentee [carpet baggers]* insert favorite scathing derogatory descriptor 10 dots !

- LV-K-1: We have to keep ethnic diversity because it will if we lose it, people will feel less pride and connection to the neighborhood. (1 dot: 0 red, 0 purple, 1 green, 0 blue)
- LV-K-2: We must honor cultural traditions in order to keep diversity in our neighborhoods through funding for events, specific cultural practices, etc. one. (0 dots)

- LV-I-2: We need more financial support for affordable housing and small businesses so we can do better with support for people who live here. In the next 10 years.

- LV-I-3: We need more food pantries and delivery services so we can do better with elder and disabled and others in the next 10 years.

- LV-D-1: In the next 10 years, crime (gun violence, vandalism, and theft) is something we should make an effort to end because it's impacts livability and safety. Instead, we should roll out home safety plans. The City should invest in more bright lighting. And the City should give rebates for security cameras, etc. because we want to keep residents living in our community.

- WK-C-3: We need to change contractors hiring people from outside the area so we can have opportunity for our residents in the next 10 years.

- WK-K-3: We have to keep charter schools because if we lose them, lack of diversity in meeting students' needs (academic, socio-emotional, cultural, gender, etc.) will happen.

WK-K-4: We must honor charter schools in order to keep the diversity reflected in our neighborhoods.

WK-K-5: We have to keep the walkability/proximity because if we lose it, we lose the community connections and the wealth and well-being of our residents.

WK-K-6: We must honor our district and its unique neighborhood feel in order to keep residents, small businesses, nonprofits, and jobs in our neighborhoods. (1 dot: 0 red, 0 purple, 1 green, 0 blue)

WORK: Increase: What we need more of so we can do better in the next 10 years (3 cards, 3 statements)

WK-I-1: We need more youth support and entertainment, athletic athletics, arts leadership, job training and jobs so we can do better with engaging our young people and helping them stay here in the next 10 years.

(4 dots: 1 red, 0 purple, 1 green, 2 blue)

WK-I-2: We need more business development, economic development, small business, and creative community support and networking and networking, higher paying jobs so we can do better with community control and ownership and self-determination (and support for) in the next 10 years.

WK-I-3: We need more affordability housing and better paying jobs so we can do better with being able to stay in the neighborhood in the next 10 years.

(1 dot: 0 red, 1 purple, 0 green, 0 blue)

WORK: Decrease: Things we should end do away with and get rid of forever. (2 cards, 2 statements)

WK-D-1: In the next 10 years, poverty is something we should make an effort to end because it is a root cause of crime and tension. Instead, we should work for affordable housing and better paying jobs because we want a thriving community right here where we can live and work.

(9 dots: 0 red, 2 purple, 6 green, 1 blue)

WK-D-2: In the next 10 years, police facilities are something we should make an effort to get rid of because it makes us feel like an occupied police state. Instead, we should have more nonprofit organizations because we want more rec centers, community-based programs and because we want a less stressed-out community. We want community-based programs, better police relations, and for police to come shop with us.

- PY-C-1: We need to change investment strategies so we can have wealth stay in our neighborhood in the next 10 years.

- PY-C-2: We need to change the way public space is utilized so that we can have a community that is free enough and comfortable enough to use public space in the next 10 years.

- PY-I-1: We need more diversity in our tax structure so we can do better with jobs and economic activity in the next 10 years.

- PY-I-2: We need to increase music in the parks so we can do better with community gathering and venues for musicians to perform in the next 10 years to dots.

- PY-I-3: We need more green space like paths and walkways. So we can do better with public gathering places and decrease pollution in the next 10 years.

- PY-I-4: We need more business investment on the eastside and diversity within the neighborhood so we can do better with slowing the neighborhood down in the next 10 years.

- PY-I-6: We need more venues where local artists can showcase themselves so we can do better with supporting and engaging artists in the next 10 years.

- PY-I-7: We need more community gatherings, sharing meals, non-threatening get-togethers (like to play games) so we can do better with knowing and supporting people. (3 dots: 1 red, 0 purple, 2 green, 0 blue)

PY-D-1: In the next 10 years, sources of air pollution is something we should make an effort to stop allowing because it's toxic. Instead, we should invest in green spaces, better regulation because we want healthy communities.

- MV-C-1: We need to change our streets to be safer to move around on (example below) so we can have less traffic fatalities, asthma, and fewer pre-term births in the next 10 years.

- MV-K-1: We have to keep bikeable, vibrant main streets because if we lose them, we lose connections to community.

- MV-K-3: We must honor diverse communities and diverse businesses in order to keep a vibrant community in our neighborhoods.

- MV-I-1: We need more safe, convenient and reliable frequent transit options. So we can do better with moving around to important places in the community without relying on personal car ownership in the next 10 years.

 (7 dots: 0 red, 0 purple, 5 green, 2 blue)
- MV-I-2: We need more safe accessible walkable communities so we can do better with building community with and for all in the next 10 years.

- MV-I-3: We need more and diverse, shared mobility/transportation options (electric scooters shared trucks to transport large items for projects etc.) so we can do better with supporting very transportation needs in the next 10 years.

- MV-I-4: We need more bikes trails and lanes with safety features like good, like great separation so we can do better with making biking safe and convenient alternative to driving in the next 10 years.

- PC-C-2: We need to change to provide investments to homeowners so we can have a safe and attractive housing stock in the next 10 years.

- PC-C-3: We need to integrate public art and increased and improved landscaping reflecting the cultures of the community so we can have increased pride, ownership, sense of belonging and sense of value in the next 10 years.

- PC-C-4: We need changes to ensure local ownership of businesses and commercial properties (instead of large corporate companies) so we can have a thriving economic ecosystem in the next 10 years.

- PC-K-2: We must honor minority business keep diversity and anti-displacement in our neighborhoods and fill vacant buildings and local owners (not chains). (4 dots: 1 red, 0 purple, 1 green, 2 blue)
- PC-K-3: We have to keep Lake Phalen and Greenspaces because if we lose it we will die. We must honor parks, playgrounds community areas in order to keep friends close neighbors in our neighborhoods and lower crime.

- PC-K-4: We have to keep historic buildings because if we lose them, loss of history will happen.

- PC-I-3: We need more trees so we can do better with urban tree canopy urban heat island index. And look and feel of community in the next 10 years.

 (5 dots: 2 red, 0 purple, 3 green, 1 blue)
- PC-I-4: We need more public art so we can do better with beautiful community space in the next 10 years.

- PC-I-5: We need more sustainable green community spaces so we can do better with creating a safe healthy environment in the next 10 years.

- PC-D-1: In the next 10 years, lack of safe and healthy communities is something we should make an effort to end because our communities deserve health, safety and happiness. Instead, we should build our community and not leave anyone out because we want a strong healthy community.

- PC-D-2: In the next 10 years, houselessness is something we should make an effort to end because people deserve places to live. Instead, we should work on ending this and help these people because we want people to have homes.

- PC-D-3: In the next 10 years, tree loss, urban blight, and pollution is something we should end because our community deserves wealth. Instead, we should plant trees work towards environmental health because we want our community to thrive (2 dots: 1 red, 0 purple, 1 green, 0 blue)
- PC-D-4: In the next 10 years, empty property and poor traffic is something we should make an effort to do away with because our community needs space and easy flow. Instead, we should make it harder for a building to sit empty because we want to have space for the growth our community is going to achieve (0 dots)
