

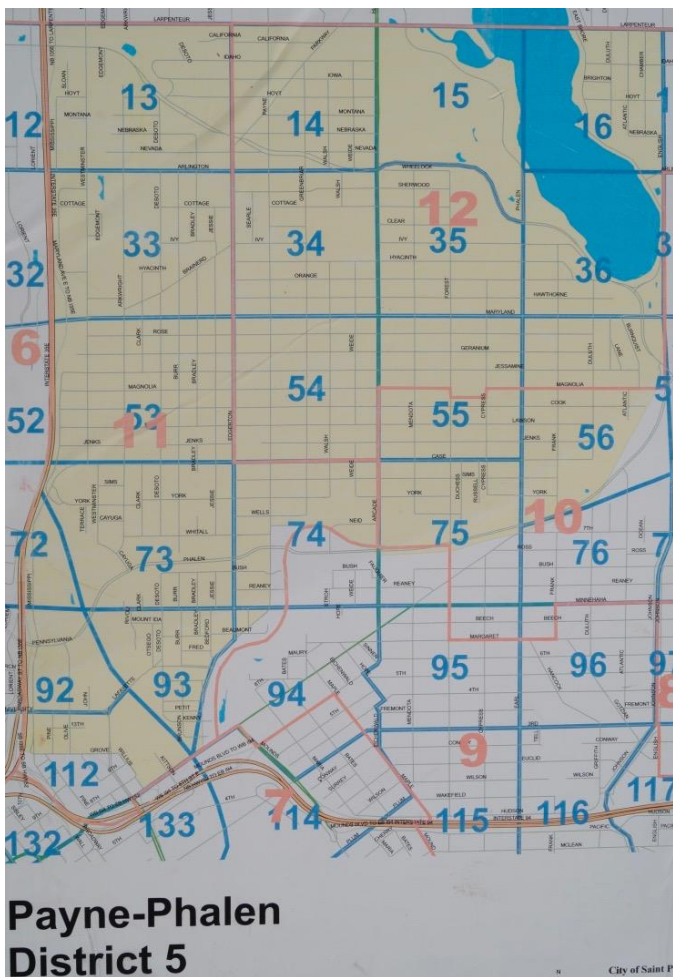
MN SNAP

SPAY NEUTER ASSISTANCE PROGRAM

Minnesota Spay Neuter Assistance Program's (MN SNAP) will be holding a spay/neuter clinic for **cats only** that are owned by residents of the East Side of St. Paul (see covered area on map below) on Wednesday, June 22, 2016 at:

St. Paul, MN 55104

MN SNAP's fully equipped veterinary clinic on wheels delivers low-cost, high-quality spay and neuter surgeries for dogs, cats, and rabbits. For this event a cat spay or neuter will be \$10. The nonprofit organization Cause for Paws will be subsidizing the balance. Rabies and distemper vaccinations are also available for \$10 each and micro-chipping is available for \$20. The organization will not pay for the vaccinations or chipping.



You must schedule an appointment for surgery ahead of time. Please submit an online registration form at www.mnsnap.org (or leave a message at 612-720-8236 if you do not have internet access). The form can be found under the Services section of our website. Once the form is submitted, you will receive confirmation from us within 1 week.

On the day of the surgery, MN SNAP's staff will admit each preschedule cat, collect the \$10 fee, and perform preoperative physical exams. During the day, all patients will be cared for by MN SNAP's highly qualified, licensed veterinarian and her team of experienced and caring veterinary technicians; patients will be anesthetized and surgically sterilized using the most current anesthesia medications, equipment and surgical techniques. All animals are discharged to their owners/caretakers the same day.
