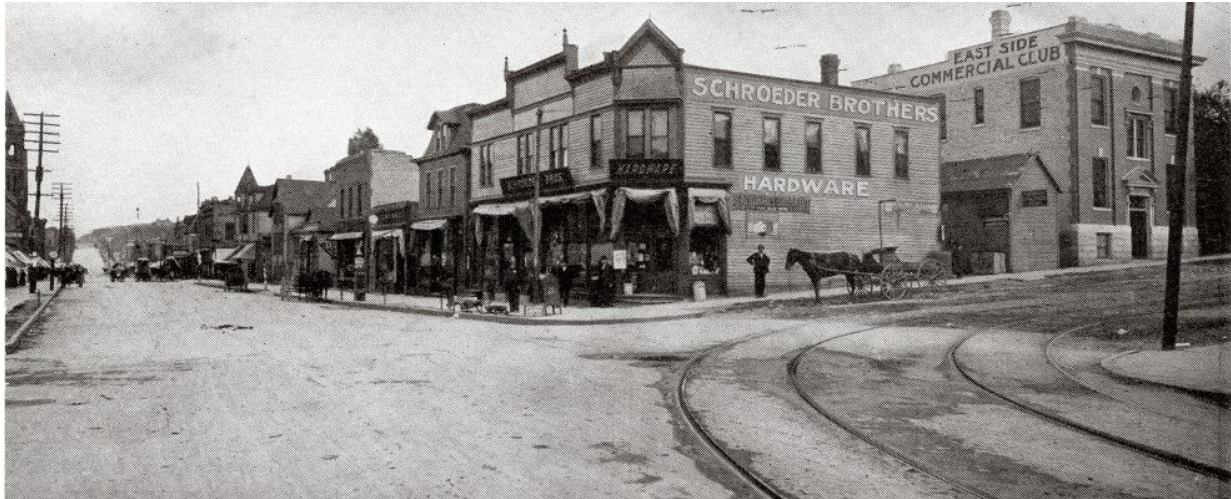




The East Side Freedom Library and Brunson's Pub invite you to a walking tour
